Course Description

- **MTM-1™**: No prerequisite. A 10-day course that includes coverage of the theory and principles of MTM-1; laboratory problems illustrating its principles and use; and thorough practice in the analysis of industrial and business operations. *BlueCard*® certification in MTM-1 will be issued to successful candidates.
- **MTM-1™ (120)**: *BlueCard* certification in MTM-1 must have been completed at least 60 days prior to taking MTM-1(120). This 5-day course gives an appreciation of the MTM Family of Systems. Generic, functional and specific systems are explained. Other subjects include Method Improvement, System Selection, Standard Data Construction, and Ergonomics. Submission of evidence of MTM-1 application is required. *BlueCard* certification in MTM-1(120) will be issued to successful candidates.
- **MTM-UAS™**: This 5-day course contains 1 day of MTM-1 appreciation, methods improvement and work simplification training. The remaining 4 days cover the theory and application of MTM-UAS. Laboratory practice in the use of MTM-UAS is provided. *BlueCard* certification in MTM-UAS will be issued to successful candidates.
- **4M™**: No prerequisite. The 5-day course covers the theory and application of 4M. The course includes laboratory problems illustrating its use and an appreciation of the theory of standard data construction and coding techniques. *BlueCard* certification in 4M will be issued to successful candidates.
- **ERGONOMICS**: No prerequisite. A 5-day course dealing with ergonomic factors that affect productivity and employee well being. Techniques used in the evaluation and improvement of the work environment are reviewed. *BlueCard* certification in Ergonomics will be issued to successful candidates.
- **MTM-B™**: This 2-day course covers the theory and application of MTM-B. Laboratory practice in the use of MTM-B is provided. *BlueCard* certification in MTM-B will be issued to successful candidates.

Programmed Instruction in MTM-1 and MTM-UAS is available for lease by companies. Please call 847/299-1111 for details.
